By-Laws Executive Committee:

Peryea Silver Taylor is reviewing of revised by-laws and the goal is suggest areas that may need revision. Attorney said there is an ongoing update to HOA laws in Washington called WUCIOA that goes into effect in 2028. We meet most of the requirements. It says Board member elections must be held by secret ballot, so we may need a few changes to our processes to comply.

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Roads:

Violations: Sent letter to owner on corner of Larson and Ajer to cut back blackberries blocking line of sight on corner.
